We are an independent local charity and Early Years Centre, based in Stevenage for children with autism and related conditions. We have a high ratio of dedicated and specially trained staff to help the children develop.

### Purpose of the Policy

Our volunteer policy has been created to show volunteers and potential volunteers that we have spent time and care in planning how volunteers will be welcomed at TRACKS. It also outlines that all volunteers will be treated in a fair and consistent way. This should also help our volunteers understand what support is available to them and what to expect from us.

### Our Vision and Mission for Volunteering

Volunteering is a great way to share your enthusiasm, skills and ideas whilst working with our children. By volunteering for TRACKS you will be making a positive contribution to the children and families that attend TRACKS. Volunteers are vital to our setting.

### DBS Checks

All staff and volunteers who attend TRACKS must have a full DBS check for any criminal convictions.

### Training

There will be an induction prepared and delivered by one of our staff. This will include:-

Information about TRACKS.

The role of the volunteer.

Introduction to other staff.

Tour of the facilities.

A copy of the behaviour, safeguarding and volunteer policies.

Safeguarding training is compulsory (this will be arranged either in house or at an outside venue). If you have a current safeguarding qualification, a relevant certificate will be required.
